
## COSTOFANINJURY







FATAL FALLS IN 2020, A TOTAL OF mployees died after a fall. The National Safety Council estimates that a fatal injury at work **COSTS APPROXIMATELY** \$1,150,000 PER FATALITY.


## OCCUPATIONAL INJURIES INVOLVING DAYS AWAY FROM WORK

OVEREXERTION, **BODILY REACTION** 

- Injury rate: 30.0 per 10,000 full-time workers
- **Typical days lost: 13**
- Most frequent part of body hurt: back

FALLS, SLIPS, TRIPS

- Injury rate: 23.1 per 10,000 full-time workers
- **Typical days lost: 12**
- Most frequent type of injury: sprains, strains, tears
