Please see below update regarding the current international shipping Market:

**Panama Canal**

Recent rain in Panama has the Canal Authority easing the planned drafting restrictions in January. Oshkosh's partnered carriers continue to have priority scheduled slots to pass through the Neopanamax locks. At the moment, we are not experiencing any delays but will continue to receive updates from our primary carriers of any changes.

**Suez Canal**

With the recent attacks around the Suez Canal/Red Sea major steamship lines have decided to avoid this area. Maersk, CMA, Hapag-Lloyd and MSC have all suspended Red Sea Journeys. MSC for example is planning on diverting vessels around the Cape of Good Hope which will add approx. 10 addition days of transit. Other carriers are trending towards traveling around the Cape as well as receiving Military escorts. There could also be additional delays with Trans-shipment dwell times as well.
